## Format:

- Announcements at 8:30 am.
- No dead ends; jacks will be re-spotted at 2-meter centerline.
- Three 45-minute games in the morning, starting at 9am and every hour thereafter. No jacks to be rolled after 45 -minute mark. Ends started before the 45 -minute limit will be completed. Fourth 45-minute game at 1:00pm after lunch break.
- Lunch will be provided by HBLBC following completion of $3^{\text {rd }}$ game.
- Top four teams will bowl in the Semifinal matches (10 ends), with the winners of each bowling in the Final ( 10 ends). Losers in Semifinal will bowl each other to decide $3^{\text {rd }}$ place ( 10 ends).
